

Y., July 4, 1876 We are assembled this Fourth day of July, 1876, in pursuance to the joint resolution of Congress, and the president's proclamation, which recommends that the people assemble this day in their several towns and cause to have delivered a historical sketch of such town from its foundation, and that one copy thereof be filed in the clerk's office of the county, and another be filed in the office of the librarian of congress, to the intent that a complete record may be obtained of the progress of our institutions during the first century of their existence. Standing as we do on ground made historical, and almost sacred, as the place where the British army under Burgoyne surrendered, October 17, 1777, the time allotted us might be made interesting, if we should dwell upon the events of that immortal campaign. But it is due to history, as well as to carry out the resolution of Congress, that we should go somewhat into detail in regard to the early history of this particular locality. It is a remarkable coincidence that eastern New York should have been discovered from different directions, by hostile interests, during the same year (1609), about two hundred and sixty-seven years ago. From the north by the river St. Lawrence, Samuel Champlain, under authority of the French, entered the lake, since bearing his name, and was the first white man who is known to have set foot upon our northern boundaries, which occurred on the 4th day of July, 1609.
